Check with the presiding celebrant and/or preacher before the liturgy begins to see if you are needed to give a reading of scripture, and read as required. Recruit one other member of the community to assist with the administration of the chalice before the liturgy begins. 		
A Person Well- Suited	Will be mature Christian, a person of prayer, and a regular worshipper and communicant at the Discovery Service for at least a period of approximately one year. Will be well organized and dependable. Will enjoy working on their own preparing for the liturgy and with others as they serve in the liturgy. Will be comfortable speaking in front of the worshipping community and with talking about their faith. Spiritual gifts that may apply to this ministry include: creative communication, leadership, shepherding, faith, teaching, and wisdom.
