crypt, unless otherwise stated.

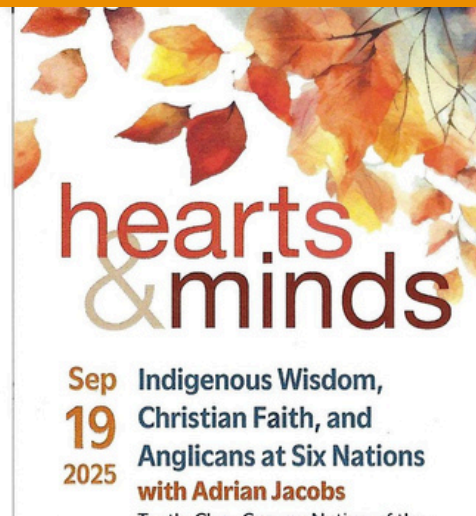
All events are open to all St John's
